



Knitted Crown Pattern

Materials Needed

4ply/sports weight yarn
Needles: 3mm (2 ¾ - 3 ¼ mm)
Tapestry Needle

Notes

Very flexible pattern. Gauge not needed.
Can use fine yarn/small needles or adapt for thicker yarn/bigger needles.
Should be firm but flexible, some stretch.

For Bobble

- K1, KITBL, K1, KITBL, K1 (All 5 stitches into 1 stitch)
- Knit 5 (i.e.. Knit over peak stitches only)
- Pass the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th stitch over the 1st stitch on right hand needle (1 stitch remains)

Pattern

- CO 6 stitches
- Row 1 (RS) – K3, Yo, knit to end
- Row 2 (all Ws rows) – knit
- Repeat rows 1 & 2, 4 more times (total of 5 times) (11 STS)
- Row 11 (RS) – K3, Yo, K7, make peaks (12 sts) – NOTE: bobbles (peaks) are optional

[Note: after row 11 the Ws is facing and the first stitch of row 12 has been knit and is on the right needle, ready to cast off].

- Row 12 (Ws) – Cast off first 6 stitches, knit remaining 6 stitches to end.
- Repeat rows 1-12 until piece measures the desired size for the doll (10 peaks, depending on the wool)

From the cast on edge

After working the last peak (row 11), cast off all stitches in row 12.

- Join together the CAST ON EDGE with the CAST OFF EDGE, being careful not to twist your work.
- Weave in ends on Ws

Sizing

To fit finished doll head size approx. 33-35cm
Adjustable – very stretchy.

Glossary

CO= Cast on
K= Knit
P= Purl
Ws = Wrong side
MP= Make peak
Yo= Yarn over increase
KITBL – Knit 1 stitch through the back of the loop
RS= Right side
